This week we the children have been using various resources to build towers, ramps and models. We have been encouraging them to revisit their work and to assess it to see if they can improve or alter it. This type of play allows them to develop their deeper thinking as well as their communication, co-operation and teamworking skills.

Following a discussion with a group of children about dustbin lorries, we turned our attention to recycling, we talked about what we can and can't recycle and why we should recycle as much as possible. We then looked at the possible uses for some of the different food packaging items in preschool.

We have also been enjoying some physical fun building obstacle courses and throwing paper aeroplanes in the outdoor area.

Applying for school Places for September 2021

Applications for Primary school places can now be made for 2021 Admissions.

Parents/carers of children who have their 4th birthday between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021 need to apply for their school place by 5pm on Friday 15 January 2021;

Parents/carers can register online to apply for a school place through the Northamptonshire County Council website

They will then be sent an email with a link which they must click on to enter the portal in order to make their application. Parents/carers must press submit once their application is complete and if they do go back into their application at any time after that (up to the closing date), they must ensure they submit again. Every year applicants who forget to resubmit are distraught as this often costs them a place at their preferred school as the application is not processed.

Summer Born application deferral requests

Parents/carers of Summer Born Children may be contacting schools to enquire about their children starting school in Reception in the September following the date they should have started school according to their age group, i.e. September 2022 start, rather than 2021.

As a reminder of the role of admission authorities, please refer to paragraphs 2.17 - 2.17 B of the School Admission Code. Specifically, 2.17A states that:

2.17 Admission authorities must make decisions on the basis of the circumstances of each case and in the best interests of the child concerned. This will include taking account of the parent/carer's views; information about the child's academic, social and emotional development; where relevant, their medical history and the views of a medical professional; whether they have previously been educated out of their normal age group; and whether they may naturally have fallen into a lower age group if it were not for being born prematurely. They must also take into account the views of the head teacher of the school concerned. When informing a parent/carer of their decision on the year group the child should be admitted to, the admission authority must set out clearly the reasons for their decision.

This is Morris the monkey. I'm sure the children have spoken about him. He helps me to lead 'Listening and Sounding' activities with the children by making it fun for them to learn how to sound out initial letters in words and also to learn to use their ears to discriminate the vast amount of sounds in the world that we live in. Each week two letters of the alphabet are chosen for the children to familiarise themselves with, and sound out. These are accompanied by pictures and objects that Morris has found to show them and make learning fun. Morris will also

be setting a weekly at home activity on Tapestry each Monday.

Sometimes Morris can be cheeky and throw his clean pants at the children, just to keep their focus, and they giggle whilst Morris and I help the children to recognise

and name basic colours. He gives them self-confidence to volunteer and speak out in a large group activity.
